4. What is sustainable and takes into account your future circumstances

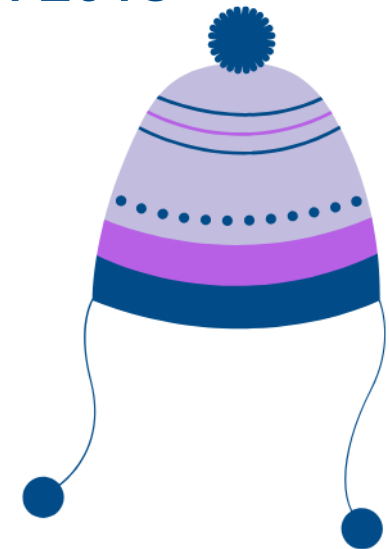
